

No Child Left Behind Notice

As a parent of a student at Melrose-Mindoro School District, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers that instruct your child. The No Child Left Behind federal law allows you to request specific information about your child's classroom teachers and requires that your school respond to your request in a timely manner. You have the right to ask for the following information in regard to your child's teachers:

- Whether the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and subjects he or she teaches.
- Whether the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction has decided that the teacher can teach in a classroom without being licensed or qualified under state regulations because of special circumstances.
- The teachers' college major; whether the teacher has advanced degrees and, if so, the subject of the degrees.
- Whether any teachers' assistants or similar paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if they do, their qualifications.
