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Parents: Please complete this short health check each morning before your child leaves for school.

SECTION 1: Symptoms

If your child has any of the following symptoms, that indicates a possible illness that may decrease the student's ability to learn and also put them at risk for spreading illness to others. Please check your child for these symptoms:

- Temperature 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth
- Sore throat
- **New** uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline)
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever

SECTION 2: Close Contact/Potential Exposure


- Had close contact (within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) with a person with confirmed COVID-19

If student is experiencing any of the following symptoms in section 1 or you answered “yes” to the question in section 2:

- ✓ Please keep your child home. In addition, please contact the Elementary or Jr/Sr High School Office to notify the school of your child's absence.

If a student is at school while exhibiting symptoms, the students will be isolated and parents will be required to pick them up. Parents should consult with their doctor to determine the need for COVID-19 test.
