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Melrose-Mindoro School District Physician Standing Orders 2023-2024

EpiPen/Auvi-Q/ Adrenaclick epinephrine 0.3 mg: to be administered by trained staff to any person **66 pounds and over** that appears to be experiencing an anaphylactic emergency*.

EpiPen Jr./Auvi-Q/Adrenaclick epinephrine 0.15 mg: to be administered by trained staff to any person **under 66 pounds** that appears to be experiencing an anaphylactic emergency*.

*A second dose of epinephrine can be given 5 minutes or more after the 1st dose if symptoms persist or reoccur.

Ventolin Inhaler (90 mcg): may be administered by trained staff for emergency treatment of respiratory distress. If SpO₂ is below 92, call parent, administer inhaler.

Naloxone: may be administered by trained staff for emergency treatment of possible opioid – related drug overdose.

Glucose: may be administered by trained staff for emergency treatment of an **unresponsive** person with blood sugar below 70.

Tylenol: Administer per directions on box/bottle for temp greater than 100.4. Update parents.

Triple Antibiotic Ointment: Apply to fresh/new wound after cleansing.

Wound Cleanser: Gently cleanse fresh/new wound.

Vaseline: Apply externally to dry chapped skin, i.e. hands.

Anti-itch Ointment: Use externally to closed skin, areas noted to be itching. Wash area with soap and water prior to applying ointment.

Rubbing Alcohol: Apply to new external piercings, i.e. ears.

Lip Balm: Apply to dry chapped lips.

Contact Solution: Use per directions on bottle.

Burn Cream: After running burn under cold water, apply cream to affected area and wrap.
